

Seasons**S(P)ring = March – May****(S)ummer = June – July****(F)all = August - November****(W)inter = December - February****Finding Codes****(c)ommon:** widespread and easily found throughout region**(f)airly common:** usually present in appropriate habitat and season but may require some effort to find**(u)ncommon:** local, occurring briefly, or present in small numbers, easily overlooked**(r)are:** only occurs every few years, very secretive, or very unusual at that season

(i)rruptive, numbers may fluctuate
